Of course dancers today have different challenges than those first Harvest Holiday members. In 1961, the dancers were taught the dances but they weren't CUED. The dances were danced from memorized cues. When you attend the 50th Harvest Holiday Festival in November, look at the dance schedule. Better yet, look up some of the golden classics. You'll notice our dancing has become much more complex over the years. With the introduction of Cuers, dance steps and choreography became more involved and a dancer's repertoire expanded. Have you heard the phrase "step cues".....my how things have changed. For the better? Guess that depends on who answers the question. Many of the active dancers today were involved with exhibition groups in prior years...they also performed all their dances from memory. Personally, I have difficulty remembering what dance just ended as I walk off the floor- could I memorize the cues to one dance? An entire evening's dance card?

For me, I like things the way they are. Although "round dancer" vs "choreographed ballroom dancer" can raise a heated discussion.....as long as the music plays and someone tells me what to do, call it what you like and let's dance 🌹
